## ACTION IN OUR AREA

Andrew has worked with a wide range of community groups and organisations to improve our local area. Here are just a few of the things Andrew has done in the past four years...

### RIGHT: HEYWOOD ROAD CROSSING

Andrew secured £14,000 of funding for the new pedestrian crossing that has just been completed on Heywood Road following requests from local people. The crossing will be of particular use to the residents of Northam Lodge.



After meeting with Residents of Northam Lodge to discuss the desperate need for a crossing, Andrew put pressure on Devon County Council to do the work immediately.



### ABOVE: SNAPDRAGON PRE-SCHOOL

Andrew secured £10,000 towards the cost of Snapdragon's new, purpose built premises. Construction of the new building will start next month and works should be completed ready for the start of term in September.



### RIGHT: EU REFERENDUM - IN OR OUT?

Andrew is a long time supporter of the campaign to hold a referendum on Britain's membership of the European Union. He is delighted that a referendum will be held in 2017 if a Conservative government is elected.



### LEFT: APPLIEDORE LIBRARY

After the library escaped closure due to the help of Friends of Appledore Library (FOAL) and Mr Walter Fowler, Andrew was pleased to give a grant toward the costly refurbishment. The library is a fantastic facility and treasured by the whole community.

### LEFT: NORTHAM COMMUNITY CENTRE

Andrew met with Hugh Brading (Chairman) to discuss plans for a car park at Northam Community Centre. Currently disabled users and parents struggle to park nearby. Groups also face difficulties when loading or unloading equipment.
