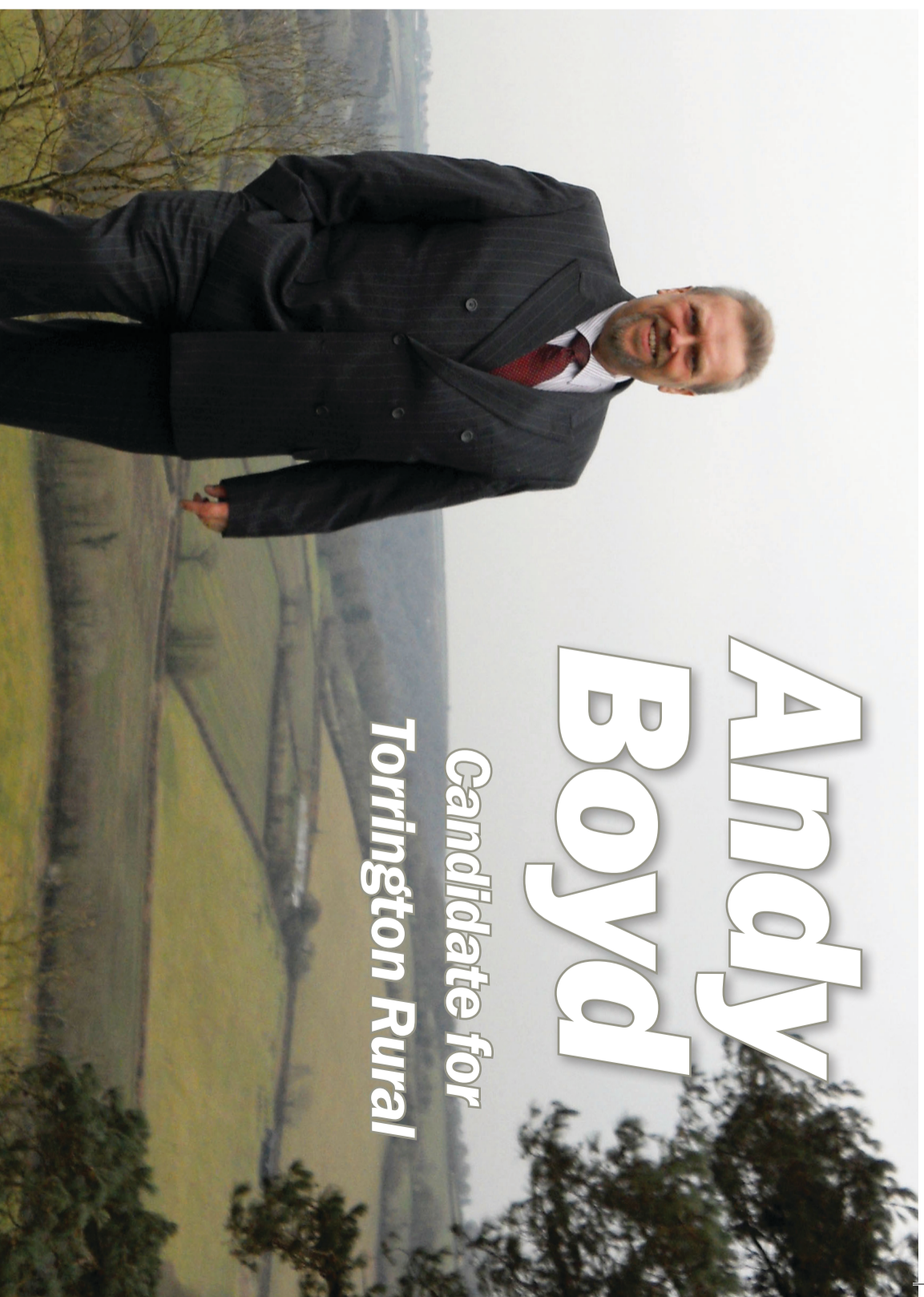
- 4** **Oppose Invasive Developments**
